

INFORMATION OBLIGATION

I. The controller

The controller of your personal data is Loyalty Partner Polska sp. z o.o. with its seated at Towarowa 28 Street Warsaw (00-839), entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register in the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw of Warsaw, 12th Commercial Division under the KRS 0000290350, NIP 527-25-58-871 numbers, share capital PLN 16,919,100.00 (hereinafter: "PAYBACK").

II. Type and source of personal data

As part of the challenge, we process the following personal data: name, surname, nickname, e-mail address, that were given during the registration of the challenge account, gender, activity statistics (that do not include location data from GPS), alternatively additional information (e.g. identification number, work e-mail address).

We have your personal data from you or from Activy Sp. z o.o. being the organizer of the challenge: Pointees Sport Challenge 2024.

Providing your data is voluntary, but necessary for you to take part in the challenge.

III. Purposes and bases of processing

As part of the challenge, we process your personal data for the following purposes:

- a) preparation and conduct of the challenge - the legal basis for data processing is Article of the 6.1.f. GDPR, i.e., our legitimate interest, which is the preparation and conduct of the challenge, and in particular the selection of winners, awarding prizes and promoting PAYBACK activities in accordance with the rules of the challenge.
- b) determining, pursuing claims, or defending against claims - the legal basis is Article 6.1.f. of the GDPR, i.e., our and your legitimate interest (protection of rights).
- c) fulfillment of legal obligations imposed on us, which result from among others., tax and accounting regulations - the legal basis for data processing is Article 6.1.c. of the GDPR, i.e., our legal obligation.

IV. Data retention period

Your personal data will be processed for the period required to conduct the challenge, and then for the period in which the obligation to store results from the law.

V. Data recipients

We may transfer your personal data to entities processing on our behalf, e.g., an entity providing consulting, marketing, legal and accounting services.

VI. Right to object

If we process your personal data based on a legitimate interest, you have the right to object for reasons related to your situation. You can raise an objection by contacting our Data Protection Officer at: mojedane@payback.net.

VII. Other rights

You have the right to:

- a) access to your personal data;
- b) rectification of personal data;
- c) deletion of personal data;
- d) restrict the processing of your personal data
- e) transfer of personal data;
- f) lodge a complaint with Polish DPA if you believe that we process your personal data in a way that violates the provisions on the protection of personal data.

VIII. Data transfer outside the EEA

We do not transfer your personal data outside the EEA.

IX. Automated data processing

We do not subject your personal data to automated decision-making, including profiling (in accordance with Article 22(1) and (4) of the GDPR).
